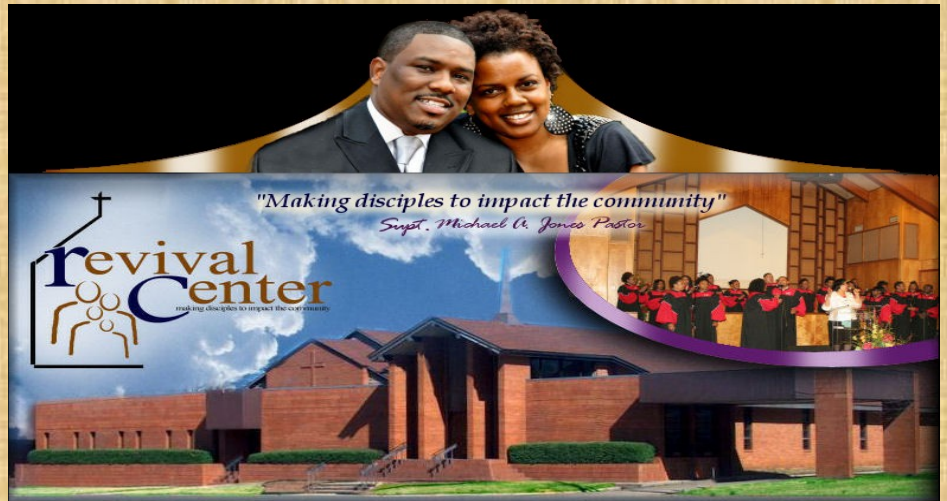

## RC Ministries

### Children's Ministry

The children's ministry plans and implements special events and activities outside the normal children's church and Sunday School program. These activities should motivate and excite children, keeping them interested in the church and Christian life while offering them a safe environment for having fun.

### Couple's Ministry

The couple's ministry provides an opportunity to strengthen marital relationships. Through mentoring between couples, small groups, marriage conferences and more experiences, couples will strengthen their marriage in key areas like communication, finances, parenting, conflict management, intimacy, etc. This ministry provides many opportunities to learn more about marriage and how husbands & wives can better themselves on several levels.

### Hospitality Ministry

The hospitality ministry ensures that every person entering the church is greeted and that visitors are offered assistance as appropriate so that everyone feels important and welcome and is able to find his or her desired destination easily.

### Men's Department

The men's ministry organizes, leads, builds up and helps the men of the church become spiritual leaders and provides an avenue of outreach to men in the community.
